REQUIREMENTS OF THE SJOA CCD PROGRAM

Holy Mass

1. To deliberately miss holy Mass, even on a single occasion, is a **mortal sin** (cf. CCC 2181). On account of the gravity of such an offense, Catholics should not fail in meeting the obligation to attend holy Mass each Day of Precept – i.e., every Sunday & Holy Day of Obligation.
2. Mass attendance of High School students in the SJoA CCD program will be monitored in order to determine whether candidates are suitably prepared to fulfill the obligations enjoined on a person who receives the Sacrament of Confirmation. See these paragraphs in the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* for more information on these obligations: CCC 1285, CCC 1309, CCC 1310, CCC 1319.

Class Attendance

1. Attendance is required. A student with more than three (3) unexcused absences during the CCD calendar year could be discontinued from the SJoA CCD program.

Behavior and Decorum

1. Disrespectful behavior or immoral conduct will not be tolerated. Such behavior subjects a student to expulsion from the SJoA CCD program.
2. Fighting on church grounds will lead to expulsion from the SJoA CCD program.
3. Students are to fulfill all homework assignments and class projects on time.
4. Students are to be respectful, cooperative, cheerful, and *prompt*.

Dress Code

1. Students in grades 1-5 may wear shorts during CCD. Shorts **must** come to the knees.
2. Students in grades 6-11 are **not** allowed to wear shorts during CCD.
3. Students may not use the SJoA facilities to change attire before or after class.
4. All students must wear shirts with sleeves covering all of their shoulders and at least part of their arms. Exercise or practice attire is **not** permitted during CCD classes; neither are shoes with cleats. When arriving for CCD classes, students must be clean and properly groomed.
5. All gentlemen (regardless of age) are to remove their hats/caps inside the Parish Hall.
6. Students who are inappropriately dressed will be sent home. This absence will be unexcused.

Mobile Devices

1. Mobile devices are not permitted during class without the *expressed* permission of the teacher.
2. A first offense of unauthorized use of a mobile device during CCD activities will lead to a **significant** extra-curricular homework assignment. The second offense **will** lead to the expulsion of the student from the SJoA CCD program.
